National Town Hall Meeting to Tackle Issues of School Testing

WASHINGTON, Oct. 17 – The Council of the Great City Schools will hold a national town hall meeting on Oct. 24 in Milwaukee to address testing issues, such as the validity, fairness, amount and practice of student testing in the nation's public schools.

The town hall meeting follows the Oct. 15 announcement by urban school leaders and chief state school officers to work jointly in a <u>commitment</u> to improve the quality and quantity of student assessments.
