LWV High School Voter Registration Program - 2018

- Since 2010, LWV has helped register more than 30,000 high school students to vote in 20+ states.
- The League is registering students in 400+ schools this spring, empowering young people to vote in state primaries and in November.
- Dozens of League volunteer teams have participated in hundreds of recent student-led walkouts and marches, registering more than 4,000 voters and attending hundreds of events.
- LWV volunteer teams focus on reaching likely non-college youth, communities of color and low income communities, key underrepresented communities in our electorate, to provide voter registration and GOTV follow-up.
- LWV program has been touted by Attorney General Eric Holder, USC-Santa Cruz civic engagement researchers, and a wide range of national partners.
- Our *Empowering the Voters of Tomorrow* training manual provides local teams with training and ideas for:
 - o Options to make teaching about elections easier and more accessible for teachers
 - Effective school outreach techniques,
 - o the latest best practices on voter registration strategies,
 - o building and managing diverse on-the-ground partnerships, and
 - systematic GOTV programs to ensure students ultimately turn out to vote.
