

Our SEL Journey

Year 1 2020-2021

Grassroots: District developed curriculum guidance and began working with stakeholders. SEL was not systematic nor systemic. Summer 2021, formed MTSS department.

Year 2 2021-2022

Beginning Partnerships: Partnered with CASEL and RethinkEd. Focused on Professional learning, specifically SEL. We began lesson implementation and development of our District MTSS plan and framework.

Year 3 2022-2023

Full Implementation: Expanded SEL lessons (designated time in schedules) currently seeing monthly growth in all areas. Heavy focus on lesson delivery, adult SEL and supporting staff on their SEL journey.





Strategic Alignments: Leveraging Opportunities

EBR had a unique opportunity to leverage ESSER funding to build SEL programing and shift existing resources to build a structure of support for students.

- Creation of Student Support Division
- Creation of MTSS and Mental Health departments
- Commitment to building a MTSS framework with SEL as its foundation

2021-2022 Removed test and 504 coordinator responsibilities from school counselors so they could focus on SEL and student support. District *ICARE*program has provided prevention education and tiered support to the EBR community for 40 years.

ALL stakeholders were looking for supports coming back to school after Covid 19 and a year of Hybrid instruction.

- Goal #1: To support the schools in their SEL implementation (RethinkEd Curriculum).
- Goal #2: To build faculty capacity around SEL and SEL best practices.

Universal Scope and Sequence

32 Week Scope and Sequence that has all students K12 addressing same topic each week with grade specific lessons.

ICARE Prevention Campaigns

ICARE program host prevention campaigns each year. RethinkEd has aligned their resources to address campaign themes allowing it to be utilized in a Tier II setting.

How creating partnerships have allowed aligning & integration of practices

PBIS Expectations

Within the Scope and Sequence, RethinkEd has aligned our district's most frequently used behavior expectations to the scope and sequence so schools can make an additional connection

Reset Rooms (ISS)

RethinkEd has aligned resources to match the Louisiana Behavior Referral, with a focus on functions of behavior, or related behaviors to use within our Reset Rooms so students receive instruction related to their infraction and not just consequences.

Multi -Agency Partnerships through the city government

Partnered with MayorPresident's office to offer tiered support and trauma informed activities to 4 high schools in areas. Safe Hopeful Healthy BR is a community investment in our students SEL and MH wellbeing Initial partnerships have allowed our work to expand with community support.


