Investment in our ReSET Program

What is ReSET?

- An intervention that is part of SEL not discipline.
- To give students an opportunity to ReSET when they are having difficulty without punitive consequences.
 - ✓ *Grief, anxiety, behavior outbursts, etc.*
- To provide students with strategies to de-escalate to regain focus to return to the regular learning environment with a minimal loss of instructional time.



The ReSET room can be utilized for a student for a maximum of 60 minutes.

ReSET Assistant Duties

Federal Funding Compliance

- RSAs are trained in *best practices* aligned to the ReSET Program purpose.
- **CCEIS requires the District** to improve students' behavior. This will result in a reduction in disproportionality and discrepancy rates in which students with disabilities are excluded from school due to suspensions and expulsions. The reduction is $\geq 25\%$ **OR** to the State target rate of $< 2\%$ of the number of students with disabilities being suspended or expelled.
- **Federal guidelines for CCEIS and ESSER** to **mandate** the ReSET Program and RSAs to record explicit ReSET supports provided to students by name, grade, GenEd/SPED status, tier level, and how RSAs spend their days.

Set-up for ReSET Success

Prioritizing the purpose of the ReSET Program

- **Understand the Program's Purpose**
 - ✓ Alternative-to-Suspension Intervention, but not ISS
 - ✓ Temporary placement for students experiencing an emotional and/or behavioral disruption
 - ✓ Student should be not assigned for long-term hours or multiple days
- **Effectively Leverage ReSET Assistants (RSAs)**
 - ✓ Misuse changes the trajectory of ReSET program
 - ✓ Utilize to support student-centered culture and climate
 - ✓ Rules without Relationships leads to Rebellion
- **Monitoring Checks & Balances**
 - ✓ Mandatory check-ins w/ SEED Advisors and TICs
 - ✓ Monthly School/Zone Data Trends ReSET Report
 - ✓ All SEED Behavioral Support Aligned to Admin Evaluation Matrix

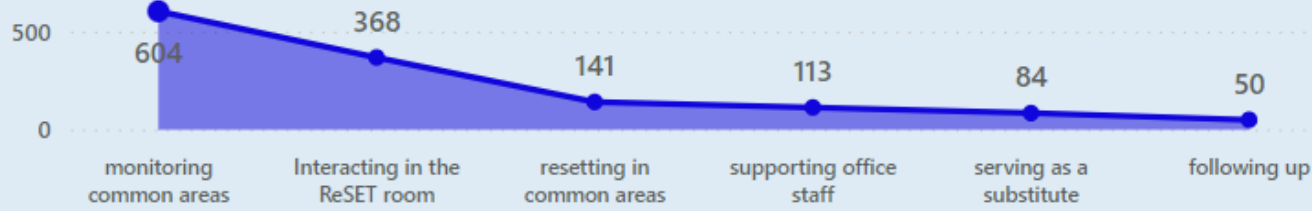

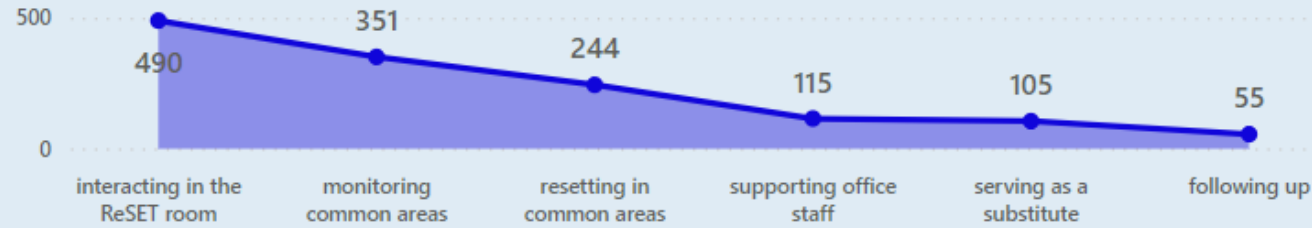

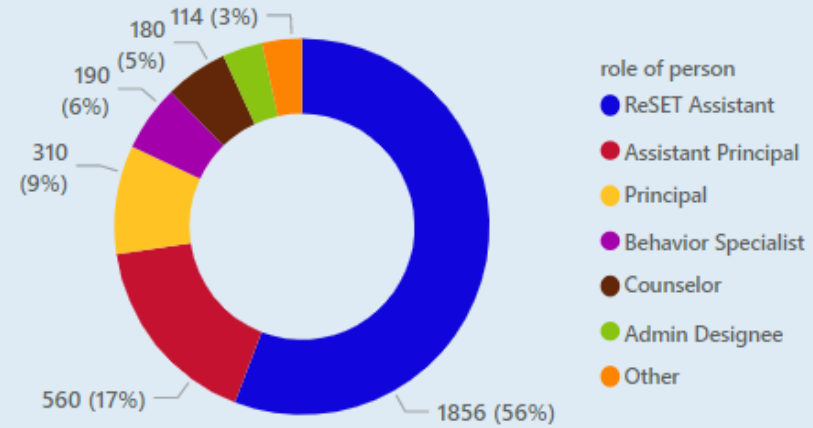
How schools are using ReSET Assistants in the AM recorded by Daily Check in reports.



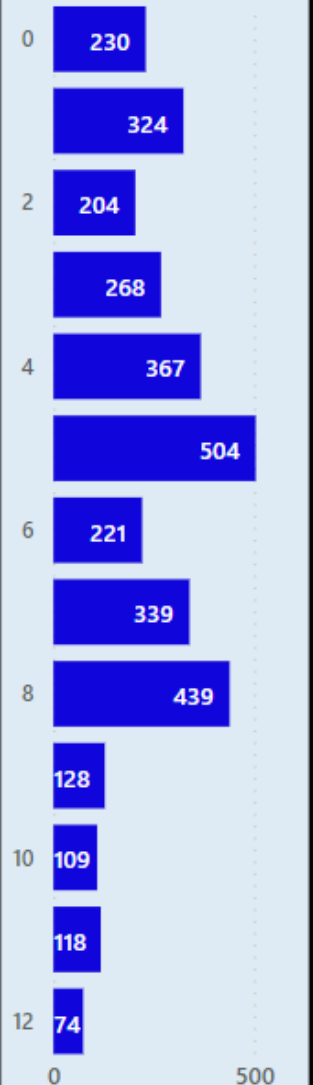
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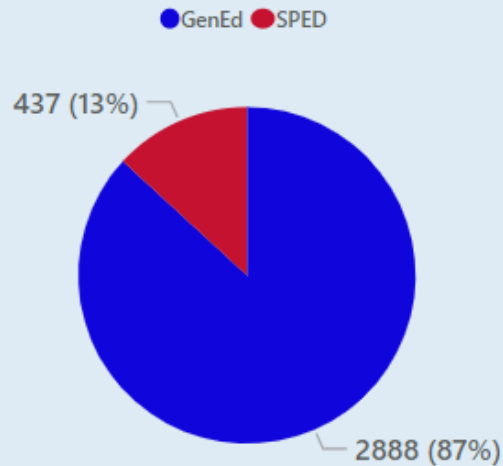
Count of referrals disaggregated by role of person



Count of Grade Level by grade level



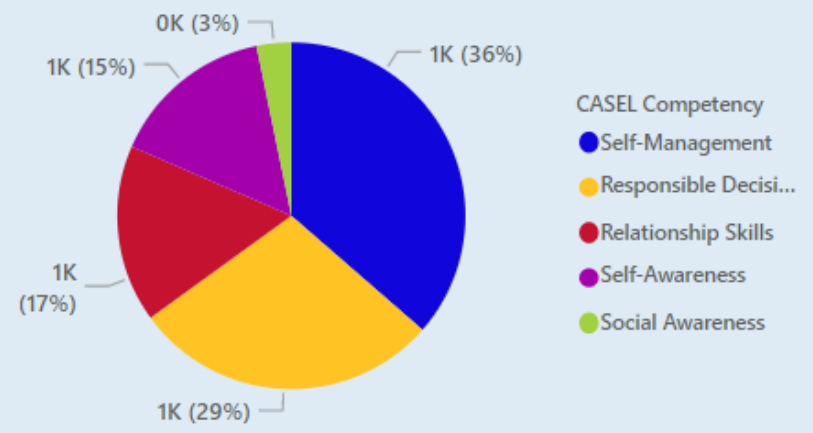
Count of Interactions by Student Status
