

# Board Action Update

**April 21, 2020**

**Tonight**, the Board of Education approved a resolution that reaffirms and proactively implements all policies, practices and procedures to ensure that our Asian and Pacific Islander (API) students, staff, families and community are not subjected to bias, harassment, discrimination, violence or retaliation.

The resolution **Condemning Xenophobic, Racist, And All Anti-Asian Attacks Elevated By COVID-19**, includes in part:

- condemnation of any anti-Asian sentiments targeting our API students, staff, families and community
- a commitment to investing resources to reach Asian parents, students, and community to support and inform them of defined efforts specifically addressing anti-Asian bias, discrimination, and xenophobia
- a commitment to partnering with public and private institutions/organizations working to address xenophobia and racism subjected to Asian and Pacific Islanders in Minnesota
