### 2013 – 2014

- Freshmen Clusters begin in High Schools

### 2014 – 2015

- Jones Leadership Academy opens as a Single Gender Magnet School
- Toledo Technology Academy 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Addition

### 2015 – 2016

- College Credit Plus implemented, including adding eight (8) AP Courses
- Gifted Services begin across the District for Students in 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade
- AVID implemented at Waite High School

### 2016 – 2017

- Urban Agriculture and Hydroponics Programs added at the Natural Science Technology Center
- Naviance implemented in 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade as College and Career Exploration and Planning
- Career Technology Courses begin for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Students
- AVID implemented at Rogers High School

### 2017 – 2018

- Reading Academy focuses work on Third Grade Reading Guarantee by working directly with third grade teachers that includes professional development and implementation sessions
- Gifted begins servicing grades 5, 6, 7 with one half day of 4<sup>th</sup> grade enrichment
- Comprehensive Mental Health Advisory Board established – made up of TPS and Mental Health Providers to establish Protocols, Procedures and identify a Universal Screener
- Recess initiative for all Elementary Students
- Transformational 9 – Decrease Suspensions by 50% at:
  - Rosa Parks, McTigue, Marshall, Leverette, Robinson, EBES, McKinley, Pickett, Reynolds
- House Bill 410 Implementation
