Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) is the sixth largest School District in the Nation and the second largest in the State of Florida. BCPS is the first fully accredited school system since 1962 with over 271,000 students and approximately 175,000 adult students in 236 schools, centers and technical colleges, and 101 charter schools. BCPS serves a diverse student population, with students representing 208 different countries and 181 different languages. BCPS employs over 35,000 full-time and part-time employees. In addition, BCPS was most recently successful in securing an \$800 million bond.

Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) has launched its National Search for the next dynamic Senior Leader to serve as the Chief Financial Officer (CFO). This is a key position reporting directly to the Superintendent of Schools and serves as a member of the Superintendent's Cabinet. The CFO will provide direction and oversight for District Finances, including development of a sound financial strategy, metrics that tie in to the District's overall strategy, leadership and control systems designed to preserve District Assets.
