### 1 MAKE A CHILDCARE PLAN

#### INFORM YOUR CHILD'S SCHOOL & PROGRAMS ABOUT CHILDCARE PLAN

-  **Update** emergency contacts
-  **Share** copies of medical information
-  **Ensure** your child has a passport

#### DESIGNATE A TRUSTED ADULT

-  **Temporary or Permanent Guardianship**
-  **State-specific form**  
(ex. Caregiver's Authorization Affidavit in California)
-  **Verbal Agreement**

#### UNDERSTAND WHO CAN GIVE IMMIGRATION ADVICE & REPRESENT YOU

#### WHAT TO EXPECT FROM A LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE

-  **Regular** case updates
- Signing** contracts
- Copies** of all documents submitted/received



### 3 KNOW YOUR RIGHTS



#### IF ICE IS AT THE DOOR

- DO NOT** open the door  
Unless ICE has a judge-signed warrant with your correct address and name on it
- DO NOT** answer questions or share personal information
- DO NOT** sign anything
- Memorize** important contacts  
You have the right to make phone calls
- Use a Know Your Rights Red Card**

- Remain Calm**
